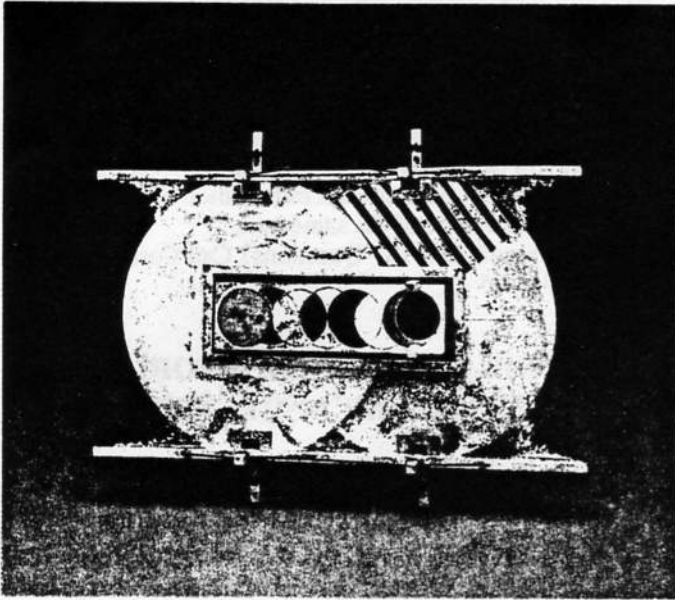

JIGS AND SMALL GADGETS FOR MULTIPLES

SMG Workshop with Joe Wood

This course is geared to the craft artist who does not object to optimizing their time in the studio. Certain simple tasks, like cutting a specific shape or length of material, or precise drilling on many similar pieces, often require repetitive measuring or marking. Usually a simple arrangement of guides (a jig), combined with the right tool can eliminate the necessity of redundant measuring and provide more reliable accuracy.

This workshop will show a variety of different set-ups for doing repetitive tasks for multiple production. Students will go through a variety of jig assisted processes to finish a constructed neck piece, plus they get to keep the jig!
