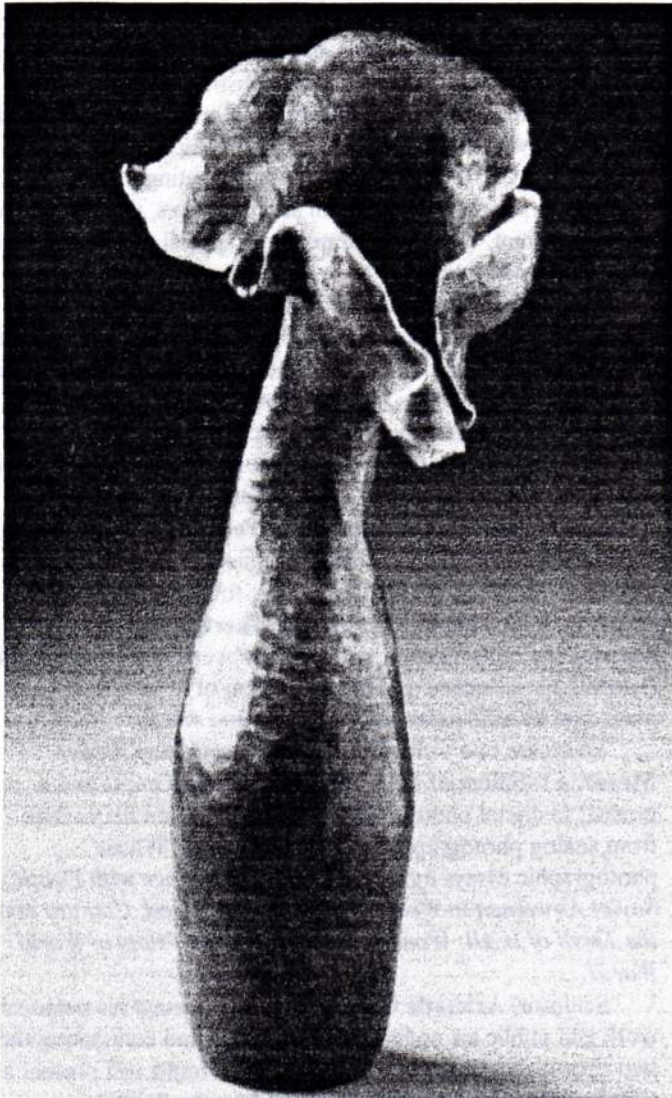

Greg Wilbur has been hammering on metal for 20 years, raising sculptural vessels and forms from single pieces of metal. His work is shown nationally at galleries and fine craft shows such as ACC, Smithsonian, and Philadelphia Museum shows. Greg will share his raising techniques in a workshop January 30 & 31st, 1999.

In 1997 Greg traveled to Japan. There he worked with Japanese Metalsmiths doing similar work to his own. In a slide lecture on January 29th, 1999 he will tell us about this metalhead adventure.

The workshop will be limited to 9 people only in order to maximize sharing of tools and Greg's attention to individual needs. Areas of interest covered during the weekend will include metals and their characteristics, annealing cooling and cleaning. Also hammers, sinking and raising, planishing, finishing, surface and edge treatment will be covered. Some information will be available on patination and, last but not least, care for sore muscles and joints.
