STUDIO ONE:

 Susan Meyers & Ephraim Russell
 10730 Lake City Way NE... house is located behind 10728 (a business called The Riley Group)

Susan And Ephraim's studio is located in the partially finished basement of the small house Susan shares with her husband, who is also an artist and teacher at Cornish. Susan says her studio is very modest - not a lot of big tools or equipment, but lots of interesting thrift store finds, give aways, throw-aways, and other "stuff". Susan's writings appear in Metalsmith Magazine, and she is a staff member at Artist Trust.

From I-5 South:
 Take the Lake City Way Exit. Stay on Lake City Way. After 5 traffic lights, look for the Lamp Shades Galore store on your right - in the following block immediately after Raymark Plumbing (with the blue and yellow sign) is the driveway to their house and studio. If you pass a large Shurguard Storage Center you have gone too far.

Susan advises visitors to either park on the street or at

one of the businesses in front of her house, and then descend the driveway to the house.

STUDIO TWO:

Lynne's shop is set up to do metal spinning. She uses an industrial process to form hollow ware and small sculpture. She has recently moved her studio into smaller quarters, so look for space-saving studio tips here. Lynne's elegant work was recently featured in the book "Color on Metal" by Tim McCreight.

Take I-5 North.
 Exit at 220th Street (#179). Turn right onto 220th. Go to 52nd Street. Take a right, south 2 blocks to 22204 52nd Ave West. Lynne's house is the yellow house on right. You might want to park at the elementary school where 220th and 52nd meet.

STUDIO THREE:

Karen runs a serious 1200 square foot production studio out of their beautiful log home. She and her husband industriously create metal light switch covers and other items. Karen and Jonathan have recently acquired some very old and interesting sheet metal equipment that they got from Benoit Sheet Metal Equipment.

Take I-5 to exit #218
 Go east on Starbird road for 1 mile-until 4 way stop. Turn right and go 1/3 mile on Bulson Road. House is on the right.
